His master's thesis topic "Influence of attack transient and decay times of percussive sounds on the echo threshold" focused on the field of musical acoustics and psychoacoustics; involving subjective testing of percussive sounds and the perception of echoes. His research led to a follow-up paper that was presented at the 19th International Congress on Acoustics in Madrid, Spain.

Before attending RPI, Indi earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Music from the University of California at Davis. He specialized in percussion performance, and after college was the percussion section leader of the La Jolla Symphony and Chorus.
