AD Scope: Audio Systems

The Juanita K Hammons Hall for the Performing Arts supports a wide variety of performances including drama, dance, music. The hall also hosts an extensive guest series with performers ranging from Peter Frampton and Wynton Marsalis to the Little Theatre of the Deaf. The Hall needed sound-systems that would be reliable for student artists and would provide the quality capable of supporting self-promoted events with limited or no outside rental.

The original house sound system, installed 10 years ago, was designed as a high-quality system; however entire portions had been deferred during construction because of project costs. AD was asked to revisit the design to not only bring it up to its original intent, but to also include any advancements in technology that would enhance the performance to meet today's standards. The new sound systems designed by AD resulted in dramatically improved system capability and technical rider compliance.
