A group of Board of Trustees members made a sizable donation to the University of La Verne Founders Auditorium renovation project with the stipulation that it be renamed the Ann & Steve Morgan Auditorium. The name may be new but the auditorium is rich in history. The auditorium is the third oldest building on campus and saw its first event, a college chapel service in 1926. Today, the auditorium is primarily used for guest lectures, recitals and music concerts. Part of the renovation called for updated AV systems. Acoustic Dimensions provided complete design services for a basic smart classroom system that includes a video projector and Screen, video and computer source equipment, audio playback equipment, and control systems.
