AD Scope: Audio

In 1996, as fans carted away bits of the old Anaheim Stadium construction, AD was hired to provide complete design services for the upgrade of sound and video systems and acoustical design for the new Angel Stadium. Components that were either at the end of their life cycle or outdated needed to be replaced. After evaluating the existing equipment and discussing the client's goals, AD decided upon a distributed sound approach for the new audio system. The system was commissioned in 1998 following a two year process coinciding with the timetable of the renovation. Part of the new audio system was integrated into the JumboTron, advertisement and informational features of the main scoreboard. The seating decks around the outfield were removed, giving spectators a clear view of the landscape surrounding the field. Flagpole speakers aimed at the left field seating areas were designed to meet sound coverage objectives while not obstructing the view.
