When Highland Park Presbyterian Church in Dallas developed a new space for their youth program, the church evaluated renovating a property just off campus. As they discussed the purchase, the ministry realized they wanted to communicate to the youth that they were connected to the ministries within the church. It was decided to renovate a formal space, Currie Hall — that was utilized by the Senior Adult ministry into the place for high school and junior high students to call their own.

Working within the envelope, F&S Partners and Acoustic Dimensions developed a main worship space for high school, a smaller worship space for junior high, a game area, ministry offices, and a cafe area. The sound system is distributed because of the low ceilings and acoustic panels were given a funky, wavy design and positioned between cross beams. Cable raceways are exposed so that there was no drilling through concrete, but covered with the same metal as the columns so that they blend in with the theming of the space.
